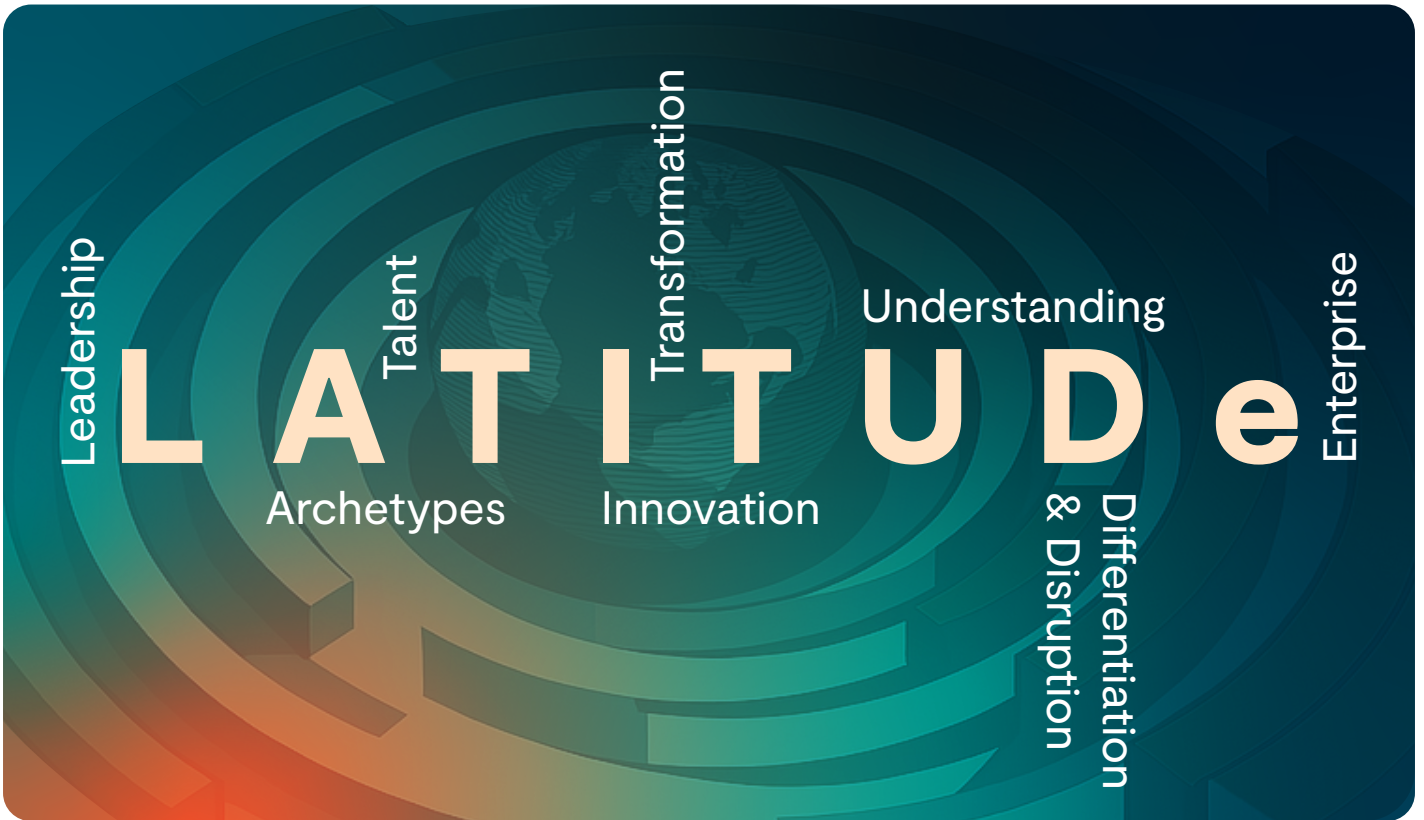

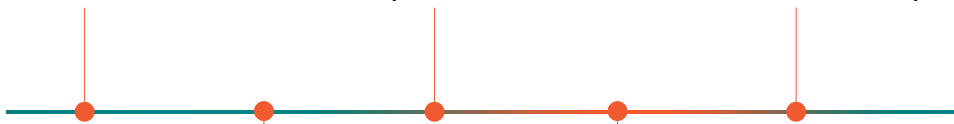

- 4** Panel review and selection notification
